Incised and painted salt-glazed stoneware

Description
Pitcher form. Raised bands impressed with patterns from a coggle wheel (a potter's tool for applying decoration), demarcate elements of the round neck and low-slung, bell-shaped body. Punched motifs adorn the angular handle and its floriated terminus. Incised abstract plant forms repeat around the neck and body.
